With reference to the e-.mail 4th cited, I submit the following points based on the discussion held with the Employees Association of ONGC. The Oil and Natural Gas Corporation Ltd's working pattern is 15 days on/off duty pattern and the employees during the first fifteen days will not be available on the next 15 days. The employees hail from various state across the country and it will be very difficult to cast their vote on a single day. Since they will be away from duty.

In this context the mail received from the CEA in the reference 4th cited was communicated to the union and the Employees Union has come with the following points for consideration.

1. The polling has been scheduled in four Districts and as the CEA has insisted that one district cannot have two separate dates for polling. Hence, It is suggested that the first phase can be (13.07.2026) held in the four Districts (i.e) Chennai, Karaikal, East Godavari (Rajahmundry) and Kakinada as scheduled and the second phase of polling can be held in another three



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Districts (i.e) 1. West Godavari Dist. 2. Thiruvallur Dist. and 3. Konaseema Dist. on 27.07.2026 (Monday) where the ONGC have an established office.

2. The members who have cast their vote on phase 1 shall be deleted from voter list and the rest can be allowed to poll on the second phase. (i.e) on 27.07.2026 (Monday).
3. Since June and July is considered as transfer period for ONGC, its stated that it is difficult to have separate voting list for each district. But it's assured that each district will have only one voting date.

It shall be ensured by the Returning Officer and team that the name of members who have cast their vote in the first phase shall be deleted from the members list and the members who have not cast their votes shall alone be allowed in the 2nd phase. Hence its requested that the Co-operative Election Authority to consider the date of polling to be re scheduled to 13th and 27th of July.

An early reply is solicited in this regard

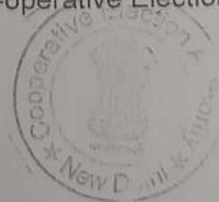
